

William Banyard's Graduate Apprenticeship has opened doors for him both onshore and offshore.

William shares why a Graduate Apprenticeship was the right choice for him and what he's enjoyed most so far.

What made you decide that a Graduate Apprenticeship was the right route for you?

At the start of my final year at secondary school, I was doing an engineering project which replaced the Advanced Higher engineering subject available at my school. This made me realise that I learned much more effectively in a practical environment.

I found the Graduate Apprenticeship scheme online and knew at this point that this was something I wanted to do. The fact that I could combine a university degree with four years of pracical work experience, all while earning a salary and without student loan debts, helped me make the decision.

Do you feel that the degree course is applicable to your current role at Well-Safe?

My course covers four separate mechanical engineering-related modules each year, which are closely related to topics in my 'day job' as a Trainee Engineer. In particular, the design and manufacturing aspect of the course has been beneficial in helping me understand tasks both offshore and when visiting vendor workshops.

Each module also includes an Individual Learning Plan (ILP), with five activity prompts enabling you to apply your knowledge from the course to your role in the workplace. The ILPs have pushed me to look outside my day-to-day role and explore the relationship between different aspects of the business.

How would you describe the support you received from the university?

As a student of Robert Gordon University (RGU), the mentors and lecturers are very supportive of the challenges which come with part-time study. I make use of weekly live support sessions, where course leaders answer any questions we may have, with assistance also provided remotely via email or forum posts online.

What's been the most rewarding aspect of your apprenticeship so far?

The main thing which comes to mind is the breadth of opportunities I've had to date.
